Supported Employment (Individual) Individual supported employment provides intensive ongoing supports and service to obtain and maintain employment in competitive integrated employment. This service includes job-related discovery, participant-centered employment planning, work incentive benefits counseling, job placement, career advancement services and more.

This service is also is used to help you to establish or maintain self-employment, including aiding you to identify potential business opportunities, assisting in the development of your business plan, identifying necessary supports for you to operate your business and ongoing assistance, counseling, and guidance once your business has been launched.

Group supported employment are services and training activities provided in regular business, industry and community settings for groups of two to eight workers receiving supported employment. This service must be provided in a manner that promotes integration into the workplace and interaction between participants and people without disabilities.



Vocational Futures Planning & Support Vocational futures planning and support (VFPS) is a person- centered, team-based comprehensive employment planning and support service that aids you to obtain, maintain, or advance in employment or self-employment/microenterprise. The VFPS employment plan is based on an individualized determination of your strengths, needs and inter-

ests, analysis of your barriers to work, identification of the assets you bring to employment, benefits analysis and support, and more.

Prevocational services are services that provide learning and work experiences, where you can develop general, on-the-job-task-specific skills that contribute to employability within paid employment in integrated community settings. These services should involve strategies that enable you to attain the highest possible wage and level of work in the most integrated setting that aligns with your interests, strengths, priorities, abilities, and capabilities.
